

## Consultations

Consultations with patient (booked, walk-ins, acutes, patient-initiated contact), could be done with HIP/HC/Nurse/other doctor, could be done in practice, urgent care, after hours, at home while on call.

For rural hospital medicine this could include assessing/admitting patients, ward rounds, ED shifts, accompanying critically ill patients to a base hospital, reviewing deteriorating patients, explaining diagnoses, calling patients about their results after discharge or outpatient clinics.
