



Applicants must have eight (8) runs total and have General Registration signed off by the Medical Council of New Zealand at point of entry to the programme (i.e. when you start GPEP1 in December of the year you applied for).

Points to note:

- If you do not have 8 runs at the application stage, you may still apply as long as you are working throughout the year to complete the 8-run total requirements
- If you have 8 of the preferred runs listed below, your application will be processed automatically.
- If your run combination is different to those listed below, your application will be processed after the application close date and at that time you will be advised whether your runs allow you to proceed to interview.

Included in the 8 run total – applicants preferably should have at least six (6) of the following specialties:

- Cardiology
- Community based attachment (which is not General Practice based)
- Dermatology
- Hospital Based emergency medicine (can have two runs)
- Ear, nose and throat surgery
- General medicine – please specify (can have two runs)
- General surgery – please specify
- Geriatrics (can have two runs)
- Haematology
- Immunology
- Musculoskeletal
- Obstetrics and gynaecology (can have two runs)
- Oncology
- Ophthalmology
- Orthopaedics
- Paediatrics (can have two runs)
- Palliative Care
- Plastics
- Psychiatry (can have two runs)
- Rehabilitation
- Reliever run (one run only)
- Renal
- Respiratory
- Rheumatology
- Rural general practice (can have two runs)
- Sexual Health
- Urban general practice rotations (can have two runs)
- Urology
